Forgive as the Lord forgave you. <sup>14</sup> And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
<b>James 1:21</b> Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you.	<b>Ephesians 6:11</b> Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes
<b>1 Peter 2:1</b> Therefore, rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.	<b>Philippians 4:8</b> Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable--if anything is excellent or praiseworthy--think about such things.
	<b>1 Thessalonians 5:8</b> But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled, putting on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.
